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Modeling Markers

For use on Modeling Mondays with the PRC-Saltillo Challenge Week. Use these cards to mark how many times you modeled each word throughout the day.

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Make the Core Spinner:

- Use a fastener, or brad, and a paperclip. The paper clip acts as the selector.
- Put a fidget spinner in the middle of the spinner. Put a sticker (or mark) one arm to be the selector.
- Poke a pencil in the middle and spin on the point. The section that it stops spinning on is selected.

Materials

- Pitcher (or container)

Directions to Make a River

- 1. Decide where to build your river. You can build it outside, in a sink, or in a bathtub. You decide where it would be the most fun to build your river! To make your river go fast, elevate the side where you will pour the water.
- 2. Gather your materials. At a minimum you will need: aluminum foil, pitcher (or other container for water), and water

Some fun things to add to your river are:

- Boats
- People
- Rocks and stones

- Animals like bears, fish, deer, whatever you want!
- A bridge (made from blocks or Legos)
- **3.** Roll out one long strip of foil. This will be your river. You decide if you want a long river or a short river. You can make it turn or stay straight. You decide!
- 4. Fold the sides up to keep the water in your river. Add your river decorations (rocks, animals, etc.).

You decide how much to roll up the foil. You can make your river wide or narrow. If you want the water to stay in the river, fold up the ends. But, if you want the water to flow fast leave the ends unfolded (and the water will flow out).

5. Pour the water into your river at one end. Have fun!
