




#### What are we looking at?





For use on Modeling Mondays with the PRC-Saltillo Challenge Week. Use these cards to mark how many times you modeled each word throughout the day.








#### Make the Core Spinner:

- Poke a pencil in the middle and spin on the point. The section that it stops spinning on is selected.


# Use this spinner with **WordPower 60 Basic**.
