Monster Slime

First make your slime. You need: white glue (5 oz.) 1/2 cup water 1/2 tsp baking soda 1 tbsp saline solution 1 container food coloring (optional)

Build a Dragon

Make your own dragon scales slime this month. Pretend you have the skin of a dragon while you play with the slime.

You will need:

- 1 toilet paper tube
- Construction paper OR paint/markers
- Glue
- Googly eyes
- Pom-pom balls, large and small
- Yellow and orange tissue paper, cut into long strips

Instructions:

- 1. Make your dragon head the color you want it to be. You can do this by cutting and gluing construction paper around the tube. Or you can paint or color in the tube.
- 2. Glue the pom-poms onto the tube. Glue the two large poms close together on one end for eyes. Add the googly eyes. Glue the small ones on the opposite end spread apart (for the nose).
