Your Next Imagination Station

Monster Slime

You'll start by making slime, then you will make it monstrously fun!

First make your slime. You need:

- white glue (5 oz.)
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/2 tsp baking soda
- 1 tbsp saline solution
- 1 container
- food coloring (optional)

First, add glue and then water to your container and mix well. Add your food coloring (if using it). Add the baking soda and stir. Finally, stir in the saline solution. Keep stirring and kneading until it is not sticky. Then play!

To make it monster slime, add in googly eyes, teeth, and anything else you can think of. Make teeth from foam sheets or cardboard. Make eyes from cardboard and paint them fun colors. Add in bugs or whatever else will be fun!

Build a Dragon

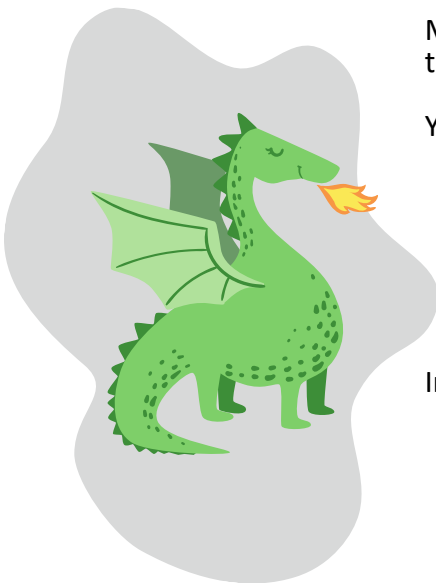
Make your own dragon scales slime this month. Pretend you have the skin of a dragon while you play with the slime.

You will need:

- 1 toilet paper tube
- Construction paper OR paint/markers
- Glue
- Googly eyes
- Pom-pom balls, large and small
- Yellow and orange tissue paper, cut into long strips

Instructions:

1. Make your dragon head the color you want it to be. You can do this by cutting and gluing construction paper around the tube. Or you can paint or color in the tube.
2. Glue the pom-poms onto the tube. Glue the two large poms close together on one end for eyes. Add the googly eyes. Glue the small ones on the opposite end spread apart (for the nose).
3. Glue the tissue paper coming out of the mouth. Have fun blowing into the dragon to make him fire-breathing.
