


Use ChatEditor to give commands to Siri and Alexa!

There are many ways to use voice assistants, like Siri and Alexa, in the classroom. Siri or Alexa can set a timer or alarm to help keep your class on schedule. Siri or Alexa can get the current weather and forecast during calendar time. Siri or Alexa can play music for the class during a break. There are MANY more tasks that Siri or Alexa can perform to help your class. And you can use ChatEditor to let the
