SCRIPT: DAY AT THE BEACH

This script, used with the modified book about a beach trip, will help to serve as a template for workshop practice with the RAA and RAAP strategies. *Each Ask/Answer set corresponds to a page in the book. **Bolded** words are glossed (aided with symbols) in the book.

Ask: **What** do you see? **Where** is this person? **Answer**: I see a starfish. He is at the beach.

Ask: Oh the sand looks wet! Do you **think** they are getting their feet wet?

Answer: I think they are getting wet.

Ask: I love playing in the sand. Have you ever been to the beach and played in the sand?

Answer: **You have/have not** been to the beach.

Ask: That's a cool castle! Have **you** ever built a sand castle?

Answer: **You** have/have not build a sand castle.

Ask: That's a pretty shell. **Do** you collect shells?

Answer: You do/do not collect any shells.

Ask: How many starfish do you see here?

Answer: I see 1, 2, 3, 4 starfish

Ask: What color is the crab?

Answer: He is yellow.

Ask: **What** shape is that ball? **Answer**: The ball is a circle.

Ask: What was your favorite thing about this book? **Answer**: **My** favorite was the yellow crab! **He** was cute!
