Key Elements of WordPower

 ** Several high frequency core verbs link directly to category pages
- 6. Early concepts with picture support
- 7. Daily routines
- 8. Lock Page function
- 9. Social pages for quick interaction and emotional regulation
- 10. Early books to support literacy and engagement
- 11. Low-tech boards
